The purpose of this camp is to prepare the Eagle Marching Band for the 2014 fall marching season. Band Camp is a pre-requisite for participation in band.

FACTS ABOUT MARCHING BAND CAMP

DATES:

Monday, August 4th through Saturday, August 9th, 2014

PLACE:

North Olmsted High School, North Olmsted OH

TIMES:

8am – 5:00pm (Monday - Thursday)

8am - 8:30pm (Friday Night) (Special Senior Evening Activity)

8am - 12:30pm (Saturday) (End of Camp Performance)

STAFF:

2 Band Directors, 2 Eaglet Advisors, 1 Percussion Advisor, Multiple College Assistants, Parent Chaperones/Boosters

FEES:

Band Camp is FREE to attend. The hard work students do to fundraise throughout the year helps to pay for this week of learning. There is a uniform fee that students must pay to have the necessary pieces/parts for their uniform. Please return the attached form with a check made out to NOBOB.

MEALS:

Students are on their own for food each day. There is a free lunch provided at the school for students through a grant. On Friday night there will be a dinner provided by NOBOB since it is our "evening activity" night

MEDICAL FORMS/Year Permission Slips:

All Forms and fees are due no later than <u>May 23^{re} 2014</u>. These forms serve as your reservation for band camp. Make sure that all forms are absolutely complete and signed with both parent and student signatures.

MEDICAL:

An Emergency Medical Form must be completed **BEFORE** your son/daughter will be permitted to go to camp. Please inform us if there is anything about your child's medical history we should know. Students with special diets should contact Mr. Kalish at (408) 813-4222 or e-mail at Erik.Kalish@nocseagles.org. Bring knee and ankle supports if you have problems with your knees or ankles.

There will be a parent 'nurse' on staff for any unexpected injuries or emergencies. If anything should happen we will contact you ASAP.

Remember- Provide the most complete and up-to-date information possible.

WHAT TO BRING:

Water bottle (it gets hot, so stay hydrated)

2 pairs of GOOD marching shoes (athletic shoes made of leather or canvas, no vinyl or plastic, or sandals)

COME PREPARED FOR HOT WEATHER, COLD WEATHER, ANY WEATHER!

INSTRUMENT:

Be sure it is in EXCELLENT playing condition. Bring valve oil, slide oil, EXTRA REEDS, extra drumsticks, and tape. Have your instrument inspected before band camp. MUSIC LYRES AND FOLIOS ARE A MUST! – every local music stores have these or you can order them from NOBOB (See the band fee form).

PERCUSSIONIST/DRUMLINE:

There is a mandatory drumline camp on July 28th and July 29th These rehearsals will be from 9-12 and 1-4pm at NOHS. Percussionists will also be having rehearsal throughout the summer. Mr. Kay as well as the percussion section leader will be contacting all percussionists before school is out.

The Drumline will placement will be chosen based on need and ability by Mr. Kalish, Mr. Kay and the Drumline Section Leader prior to the end of the school year. If a specific instrument is desired, feel free to let Mr. Kalish know.

SWINGS AND THINGS:

It is a yearly custom to go to swings and things as a band on Wednesday night of band camp. All students are encouraged to participate. There is a fee associated with the participation. Please fill out the attached form and return it with payment with the other forms.

Band Rehearsals will take place every Wednesday night during football season from 6pm-8:30pm

NOTICE: FOOTBALL GAMES AND PERFORMANCES BEGIN in late August and continue until the end of October. (PERFORMANCES MAY BE ON SATURDAYS OR FRIDAYS)

PLEASE SCHEDULE TRIPS AND VACATIONS BEFORE THE SEASON
STARTS (trips and vacations are unexcused absences to band
performances and rehearsals and will negatively affect the student's grade)

BAND CAMP RULES

- 1. No smoking materials, tobacco products, non-prescription drugs, or alcoholic beverages permitted at band camp.
- 2. ABSOLUTELY no hazing of freshmen permitted.
- The NOBOB chaperones and camp staff MUST be obeyed and treated with respect. They have the same authority as the directors.
- 4. Students are permitted to leave campus during camp only for lunch from 12:00-1:00 each day.
- 5. No excuses for tardiness will be accepted.
- 6. No bare feet or sandals permitted on the marching field or parade block.
- If needed: All prescription medication will be labeled and turned into the parent/nurse. Students are responsible for taking their own medications, but will be reminded to do so by the nurse if necessary.
- 8. In addition, all rules of North Olmsted High School, and North Olmsted City Schools will be in force during the entire duration of the camp. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action by the directors.
